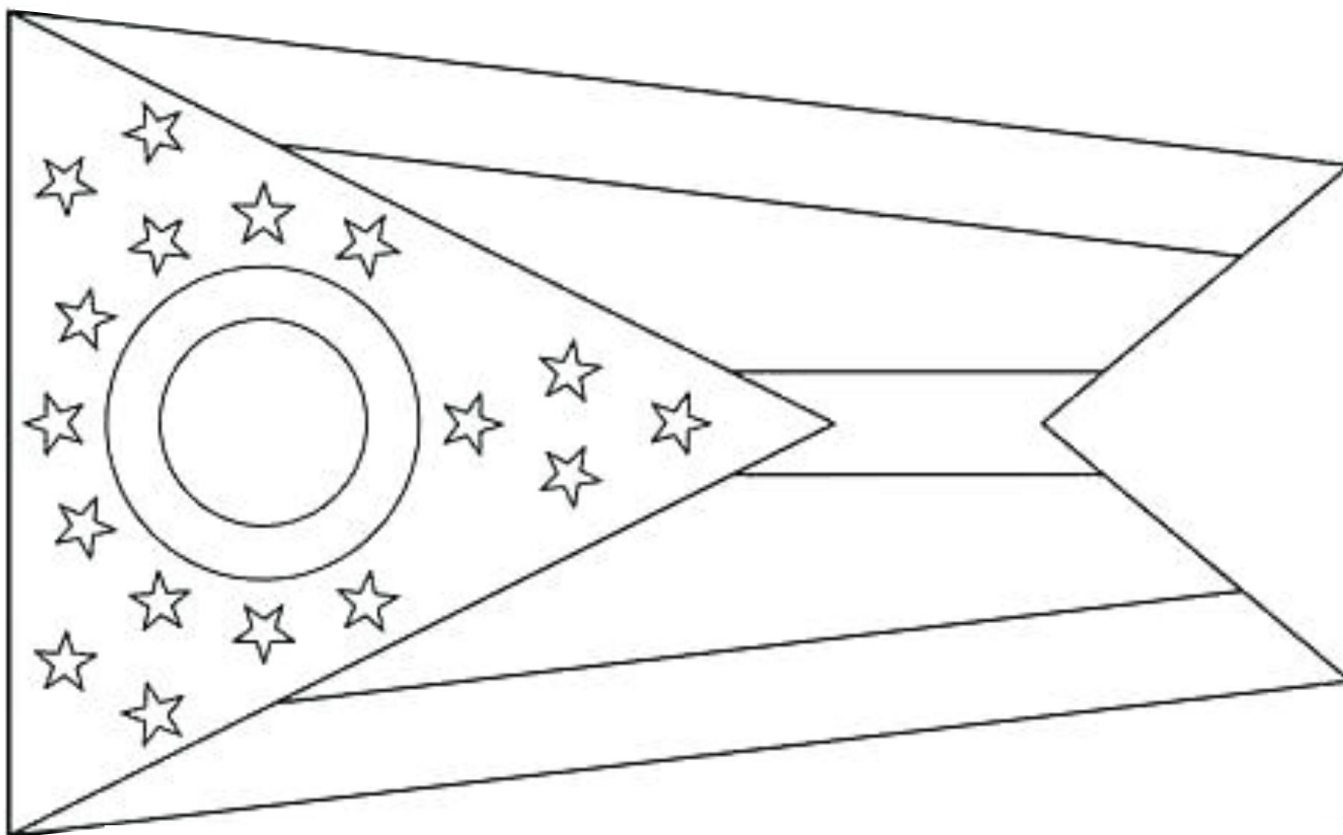


Color the State of Ohio Flag



Red – color the first, third and fifth stripe red and the center circle

Blue – color the triangle behind the stars blue

White – color the second and fourth stripe white, the stars and the outer circle

Fun Facts

- Ohio did not have a flag for nearly 100 years.
- Ohio is the only state with a flag that is not rectangular.
- The red and white stripes represent Ohio roads and highways. The blue represents hills and valleys. The round red “O” in the flag is for the name of the state and because it’s the “Buckeye State.” The 17 stars represent Ohio entering the United States as the 17th state.
- Today, each of the stars represents a state.
