Red – color every other stripe red, starting and ending with red. **Blue** – color the field (called the union) behind the stars blue **White** – the stars are white and the stripes which are not red

- The 13 stripes are for the 13 original colonies. The 50 stars represent states.
- Nicknames for the flag are: Stars and Stripes, Old Glory, and Star-Spangled Banner.
- Our current flag is the 27th design and the longest used version of the flag.
- There is no proof Betsy Ross made the first stars and stripes flag.
- The flag should never be allowed to touch the ground.
- The flag must have light shown on it if flown at night.
